

Primary Pupil Premium Allocation

2017-18

For the academic year 2017 – 18, the Primary school has 5 pupils who qualify for the pupil premium. This totals £6,600. The funding provides for ‘Better Reading Partners’ (1:1 reading support work) with those who qualify in Year 1 and Year 2. An additional sum provides funding for the extended day in support of pupil wellbeing.

2016-17

During the Academic Year 2016–17 the primary had a pupil premium (pp) allocation of £3,964 for 3 pupils. Our allocation is spent delivering enhanced reading provision, and one-to-one teaching as is necessary for the 3 pupils.
